

Air

SUNSHINE COAST AIRPORT (MCY)

Noosa is a 30-minute drive north of the Sunshine Coast Airport. A new international runway was launched in June 2020, and will attract new direct connections from domestic and international destinations.

BRISBANE AIRPORT (BNE)

Brisbane Airport is 90 minutes' drive from Noosa and is Queensland's domestic and international gateway, operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Road

Noosa is a 90-minute drive north of Brisbane on the Bruce Highway. All major car hire companies operate to and from Noosa. Shuttle services, limousines and private cars are all available to transfer to/from Brisbane and Sunshine Coast Airports to Noosa.

Greyhound Australia operates an extensive bus network around Australia, with Noosa a popular stop for many travellers. greyhound.com.au

Distance (kms) & drive time (hours) from Noosa to major centres






Destination Green

UNESCO Biosphere Reserve

Noosa was declared a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve in 2007. Biosphere status is awarded to destinations that are committed to creating harmony between people and nature. Noosa's

community has a long and strong history of protecting large tracts of land and low-rise development which are some of the reasons for Noosa being declared a Biosphere Reserve.

Noosa is one of only two Biosphere Reserves in Queensland, along with the neighbouring Great Sandy Biosphere Reserve, the only two Biospheres in the world that sit side by side.




World Surfing Reserve

TAKE 3 FOR THE SEA


Take 3 pieces (or more!) of rubbish with you when you leave the beach or anywhere and you'll make a difference.

Discover pristine bays and open surf beaches




The calm, sheltered waters of Noosa Main Beach offer perfect learn-to-surf waves. It is one of the few beaches in Australia that faces north and is protected by a headland.

Drive the beautiful coast road and explore seaside villages from Sunshine Beach through to Peregian Beach. Nature surrounds with National Park walks and the serene Lake Weyba.

Hastings Street


Bordering Noosa Main Beach is Hastings Street with an eclectic offering of boutique shops (many selling local labels) and a mouth-watering mix of well-regarded restaurants, cafés, bars, coffee nooks and ice cream shops.

Noosa River

A water enthusiast's paradise



With everything from stand-up paddle and jet skis, to fishing and boating, the river extends all the way from the ocean to the Noosa Everglades. Pause to watch the large population of bird species, including the White Bellied Sea Eagle, Brahminy Kites, Great Egret or the much-loved Pelican.



Noosa Everglades

This pristine wilderness area is fondly known as the 'River of Mirrors' due to its amazing reflective and pure waters. The area is a photographer's dream, a bird watcher's paradise and a nature lover's dream escape.



Noosa National Park

Stunning coastal and bush trails

Consistently recognised as a top Queensland experience, Noosa National Park – one of the most visited in Australia – rewards visitors with a variety of walking tracks; stunning coastal, bush and rainforest scenery; and hidden bays offering world-class surfing breaks.

NATURE

Koalas, dolphins, whales and turtles frolic here, which is an easy boardwalk stroll from bustling Hastings Street.



The Noosa Coastal Walk

One of the only National Park trails in Australia where you can walk alongside the ocean all the way around the headland. This iconic 10.8km (return) coastal trail leads you to the southern end of Noosa National Park, with glorious vistas to neighbouring beaches including Sunshine Beach and Peregian Beach, which are also popular with visitors.

Scenic hinterland trails



Explore one of the eight scenic hinterland trails, suitable for walking, biking, horse-riding or birdwatching – or climb a mountain for stunning views. Stop at one of the hinterland towns and visit a brewery, distillery, farm gates or one of the unique village stores.

Great Beach Drive and Cooloola Great Walk

88km of stunning ocean and national park scenery

Between Noosa and Rainbow Beach is the Great Sandy National Park and Cooloola Recreation Area. The area is home to Teewah Coloured Sands, the pristine wilderness of the Noosa Everglades, long stretches of beach, forests, paperbark swamps, wildflowers, rare and endangered animals, with stunning views and walking trails.

This is the only place in the world where two UNESCO Biosphere Reserves sit side by side - the Great Sandy Biosphere and Noosa Biosphere. Explore stunning coastal and bushland scenery along The Great Beach Drive in a four wheel drive tour, driving on the beach from Noosa.

Or if walking is more your thing, hike 88km on the Cooloola Great Walk. Each experience offers a rich diversity and a once in a lifetime journey.



TIP Keep a watch out for migrating whales from July – November.

Celebrating fresh local produce



Noosa boasts a bountiful supply of fresh local produce due to fertile soil of the hinterland and an abundance of pristine waterways. Offering everything from hand-picked strawberries, macadamias, crab or juicy red tomatoes, local produce is easily sourced from the farm gate, farmers markets, Noosa restaurants, cafés and even local supermarkets.

Noosa's foodie reputation is held in high regard, home to several Australian leading chefs and five restaurants that are rated in Australia's top 100. Noosa is also well known for the acclaimed Noosa Eat & Drink Festival held annually.

Kayak, canoe or cruise through the stunning Noosa Everglades, one of only two Everglades in the world. Discover an ancient system of waterways with clear lakes and dark tannin waters that provide stunning mirrored reflections.

Venture to the Noosa hinterland surrounding this coastal getaway, dotted with lakes, lookouts and scenic trails. Historic towns welcome you with cafés, galleries, farm gates and markets. Stay in lakefront cottages, B&Bs, health retreats or glamp under Noosa's starry skies.

Home to globally awarded day spas, Noosa is the perfect escape to restore life's balance. Unwind with luxurious pampering in a day spa, massage room, healing retreat, yoga on the beach or state-of-the-art Pilates studios.

The calm waters of the Noosa river are perfect for safe swimming, jet ski fun, sailing, kayaking, stand-up paddling or fishing. Jump onboard the Noosa Ferry or a sunset river cruise to soak in the views.

There are several nearby attractions to excite and thrill. Cuddle a koala at Australia Zoo, board the Mary Valley Rattler steam train, visit the Ginger Factory, SEALIFE Sunshine Coast, Aussie World or the Maleny Botanic Gardens & Bird World.

10 UNCOVER THE ART SCENE

Noosa showcases creations from talented artists including landscapes, portraits, photos, indigenous and abstract art, sculptures, jewellery, 3D creations, furniture, fashion, glass work, homewares and more. Join a tour, taking you behind-the-scenes of the most respected artists' studios and galleries.



Noosa's Neighbours

Noosa works in partnership with Visit Sunshine Coast, Fraser Coast Tourism & Events and Destination Gympie Region, to offer visitors day trips or overnight stays with some of the most breathtaking natural scenery you can experience in Australia, just north of Noosa.



K'gari and Hervey Bay

World Heritage-listed K'gari (Fraser Island) is the world's largest sand island and an area of remarkable natural beauty. Blessed with long white beaches, coloured sand cliffs, sand blows, rocky headlands and amazing clear freshwater lakes, it is a perfect extension to your Noosa holiday. Swim in over 100 freshwater lakes including Lake McKenzie and Eli Creek, walk through towering rainforest, drive on 120km of beach highway and visit the Maheno Shipwreck. The whales' playground of Hervey Bay is about a three-hour drive north of Noosa on the Bruce Highway, where you can join a half-day whale watching tour in calm waters, spotting humpback whales with their calves.



Rainbow Beach


Join a guided tour or hire a 4WD and travel 60km via the Great Beach Drive from Noosa to the beachside town of Rainbow Beach. The town is a hidden treasure and offers a breathtaking coastline, 72 shades of coloured sands on cliff faces and some of the best coastal views in Australia.

Do not miss the magnificent sunrise or sunsets at Carlo Sand Blow, a 15-hectare sand mass that is over 500,000 years old. Marine and wildlife are abundant, including millions of soldier crabs, thousands of whales (seasonal) and is a breeding ground for the endangered Grey Nurse Sharks, which attracts divers from around the world.



Lady Elliot Island

Flights to Lady Elliot Island depart daily from Hervey Bay Airport, about 3 hours' drive north of Noosa. Explore this underwater wonderland from the award-winning nature-based resort – perfect for a day tour or overnight stays. Snorkel (safe for beginners) or dive the southern-most point of the Great Barrier Reef and explore nature's seasonal migration including turtle nesting, giant manta rays, humpback whales and sea birds, as well as a year-round array of other marine life and unspoilt coral reef.



Suggested Itinerary

Every visit to Noosa requires at least a day exploring the town. Most people wish they could stay longer once they realise the breadth of offerings, using Noosa as a base.



DAY 1

- Soak up the natural beauty in the Noosa National Park and learn to surf in a World Surfing Reserve. Drive the coast road to explore Sunshine, Sunrise or Peregian Beach villages.
- Board the Noosa Ferry and cruise along the Noosa River, hire a jet ski or spot dolphins on a jet boat ride.
- Shop at the many boutiques lining Hastings Street and dine at one of the award-winning restaurants with beachfront or river views.



DAY 2

- Visit the Noosa Everglades. Cruise, kayak, canoe or helicopter above the 'River of Mirrors' known for its breathtaking reflective waters.
- Don't forget your camera as the area is home to over 44% of Australia's bird species, Eastern Grey Kangaroos, echidnas, koalas and a variety of other Australian wildlife.
- Glamp under the stars




DAY 3

- Explore the lesser known side to Noosa traversing the countryside. Home to exquisite local produce at farm gates where you can try feijoas, pick strawberries, taste ginger and finish at a craft brewery.
- Adventure out on the Noosa Trail Network joining a mountain biking or horseriding tour. Hike up Mt Tinweerbah or Mt Cooroora for spectacular 360-degree views.
- Jump on board a historic steam train, visit a tranquil botanic garden, or treat yourself to a day spa.

DAY 4

- Join a 4WD tour from Noosa, driving on the sand. The 88km journey passes through Rainbow Beach and all the way to Fraser Island. At Double Island Point Lighthouse look out for humpback whales in season (June – November).



DAY 5

- Visit one of our neighbours. A full day will take you to world famous Australia Zoo, World Heritage-listed K'gari (Fraser Island) or Lady Elliot Island, home of the Manta Ray.

Habitat Noosa is uniquely located in the Cooloola National Park, a short 10 minute boat ride from the world famous Noosa Everglades, and a 25-minute shuttle transfer from Noosa.
